Jesus, Yeshua, is the light of this world.

Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life." John 8:12

"I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness." John 12:46

With each ascending degree, Masons seek <u>more light</u>. However, prayer offered to the god of Freemasonry, the Great Architect Of The Universe <u>cannot</u> end in the name of Jesus, as this would <u>offend</u> other faiths in the Lodge.

One question for the Christian Mason.

If <u>God, Yahweh</u>, was in fact the Great Architect Of The Universe, how could prayer in the name of <u>His Son</u> offend <u>Him?</u>

Manly P. Hall says in his book, <u>The Lost Keys of Freemasonry</u> on page 48, "When the Mason learns...the mystery of his craft. The seething energies of Lucifer are in his hands and before he may step onward and upward, he must prove his ability to properly apply energy".

God's Word says, "You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons; you cannot partake of the Lord's table and of the table of demons." 1 Corinthians 10:21

"...For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light." 2 Corinthians 11:14

Jesus says, "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it." Matthew 7:14

.., "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." John 14:6

Yet Freemasonry teaches <u>another way</u>. It teaches that the Bible is a 'movable piece of furniture'. It teaches that Jesus, Buddha, and Confucius were great reformers. It teaches salvation by good works without Jesus

Will the Christian Mason filled with the light of Lucifer meet a forgiving God?
